General Summary:

ALZ Companions Interns provide in-home support to caregivers of individuals with Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia. Interns provide companionship, socialization and supervision for individuals with dementia, allowing their caregiver to enjoy a break. Interns do not help with any physical or personal care.

Objectives (85 hours total):

- Be a companion to an individual living with dementia 70 hours
- Attend education classes 3.5 hours
- Help with a social activity 1.5 hours (or attend additional education class)
- Work on a project research, activity or Programs assistance 10 hours
- Submit thoughtful visit reflections/reports throughout course of internship
- Receive a certificate of completion; may receive a letter of recommendation

- Pay attention to and follow specific instructions as provided by the primary care partner, unless inappropriate
